Whilst we hope your child will be happy and content at the club, we understand that sometimes questions, concerns or difficulties may arise. Please do raise any concerns as soon as possible, so we can rectify things at the earliest opportunity.

If you have a question regarding coaching/team issues, please approach the coach/manager in the first instance. Our coaches/managers will be happy to speak to you before or after training or at another convenient time. Please do not interrupt any sessions, as this may distract them when he or she needs to be supervising the children.

If you have any concerns about your child, another child or about the behaviour of any adult at the club, please speak to me or Jane who are the Club Safeguarding Officers. You can contact me on 07889 203325 or Jane on 07989 322896. Jane will also be at the majority of Junior training sessions on a Friday as she has children who attends.

We have recently updated all of the Club policies, code of conducts and general information in regard to safeguarding. These can now be found on our website. There are also copies of many on the Notice Board in the Foyer and Changing Rooms.

The Junior Membership Form has been changed as well, so it is important that you compete this fully; **any forms that aren't complete will have to be sent back.**
