Open to boys and girls aged 6-13yrs

Sessions will be run from 10am to midday and 1pm to 3pm.

There will be a break for lunch (during which the children will be supervised at the club)

Coaches will be at the club between 9am and 4pm for early drop off and late pick up if required.

Why join our Summer Junior cricket academy?

- Enjoy a sporty end to the summer school holidays
- The main aim of the course is for children to learn in a fun and safe environment
- All sessions are geared to the children's abilities, so whether you're a serious budding Joe Root, Heather Knight, or an absolute beginner, the coaches will adapt the sessions to benefit all.

What do I need to know?

- Junior members of Clifton Cricket Club will be given first refusal on the course places.
- Coaches used on the course will be fully English Cricket Board (ECB) qualified.
- Children must not arrive at the venue before the start time as they will be unsupervised.
- A parent or guardian must collect the child each day. Coaches must be informed.
- Clifton Cricket Club or the coaches cannot be held liable for any loss, damage or injury that might occur during the course.

What will the children need to bring?

- Training / playing kit – plus an extra set of clothes to change into should the weather become inclement.
- Correct footwear – trainers only. No cricket spikes to be worn.
- Any medication required by the child. This **MUST** be stated on the enrolment form.
- Packed lunch.
- **PLENTY OF FLUIDS.**
- Lots and lots of energy!!

How much does it cost?

- The total cost for the full week is £75 per child (if you have more than one child who wish to attend, please see Jim for a discounted '2nd child' rate)

What do I need to do to enrol?

- Simply complete the enrolment form on the reverse of this sheet and hand it with the full payment to either Jim Ainscough (CCC U17s manager/coach) or your own junior team manager.
- Enrolments will be processed on a first come, first served basis and places are strictly limited.
- Your child will automatically secure a place on the course with the correct payment (we will contact you if unsuccessful).
